IGADI opens the registrations for the ONLINE Conferences "The Xacobeo 2021 and the Silk Road: Paths to The East-West Dialogue"

- The Conferences will create on 14, 15 and 16 October 2020 a global forum around relations between Galicia and China, Spain and Portugal, within the framework of the European Union-China dialogue and the United Nations 2030 Agenda.
- Researchers and analysts from entities such as the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences, the Royal Elcano Institute, the Institute of the Orient (Portugal), the Macau Forum, the Chinese Chair, the Center for East Asian Studies and Research (UAB), the Association of Friends of the Camino de Santiago in China or the Association of Galician people in China, among others, will participate in the Conferences.
- The full program of the Conferences can be found on the website www.china.hub.gal where the Galician Institute of International Analysis and Documentation (IGADI) also centralizes registrations, which are free.

The conference is distributed in three intense days with morning and afternoon sessions. Experts from China, Spain, Portugal and Galicia will participate throughout the 10 scheduled sessions. Economists, political scientists, journalists, researchers or language teachers meet to learn about and reconsider Galicia's relations with China and the European Union-China dialogue, within the framework of the 2030 Agenda and the Covid19 global pandemic.

The final dialogue at the last session of the Conferences, on Friday, October 16 at 18:00, among the Galicia-China Network identified within the IGADI report as part of the project, aspire to put on the table all the potential of a Galician external action with a will to provide returns to our society.

The Conferences put an end to the first phase of the project "The Xacobeo and the Silk Road: Paths towards East-West Dialogue" (initiated on November 1, 2019) that was born from the call "O teu Xacobeo 2019" promoted by the Xunta de Galicia and the collaboration of the municipalities of Santiago de Compostela, A Coruña, Pontevedra and Lugo. In the project devised by IGADI, Casa Asia collaborates in a very special way.

For formal registration, which entitles you to a certificate if you exceed 60% of the attendance, the ZOOM application, the virtual environment where the Conference will take place, will be required. Furthermore, the conference will also be broadcast openly live on the IGADI Youtube Channel.
